- Heavy, Uncontrollable Bleeding
- Severe Broken Bones
- Poisoning

WHEN IN DOUBT, **DIAL 9-1-1**

Did you know...

an ambulance must respond to every 911 call? If a call is not for an emergency, it could increase the amount of time it takes an ambulance to respond to a life threatening emergency call, so it is vital to know your options before calling 911.

ARE YOU PREPARED FOR AN EMERGENCY?

Please keep these things in mind:

- When calling 9-1-1, remember to stay calm and answer all questions fully.
- Make sure your address is visible from the street in the daytime and at night.
- Keep a list of your current medications with dosage, allergies, and healthcare providers on your fridge for responders.
